



## Call for Papers

We kindly invite you to submit a paper for possible inclusion in issue 4 (2023/24) of the PHDL publication series (Trauner Verlag) with the title:

### *Teaching English Has No Limits*

The issue welcomes contributions covering a current topic or recent study in the field of **Teaching English as a Foreign Language (EFL)**. It is a venue for **theoretical** discussions, **empirical** research, as well as contributions which are primarily **practical** in nature.

We are aiming at providing a platform for researchers and practitioners who focus on EFL teaching in **elementary, primary, secondary** and **tertiary education** to present **new developments** in the area. Final manuscripts should be about **6,000 words** long (including an abstract and the bibliography) and follow the formal and stylistic requirements as laid down in the APA Publication Manual, Seventh Edition (see [here](#) or [here](#)).

#### Timeline

Please let us know by **September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023** if you are interested in contributing to our publication by sending us a **provisional title and a short description of your text**.

The **complete manuscript** is due after the Christmas break, i.e., **January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024**. This version will undergo a blind peer-reviewing procedure and you will receive feedback by April 8<sup>th</sup>.

The **revised manuscripts** need to be handed in by **July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024**.

After adding the finishing touches, everything will be ready for publication in **September, before the start of the academic year 2024/25**.
