Project Description

The institute for media education at the PHDL and their international partners are actively engaged in organising the annual "Education & Technology" Summer School. In addition to hosting the school at the partner universities in Norway, France, Austria, Indonesia and Germany, a new partnership with Kyrgyzstan was established. An essential aim of the Summer School is the advancement of international collaboration between the partners as well as networking of young researchers. The Summer Schools offer events to present research topics as well as to discuss scientific studies, empirical methods and more. The Education and Technology Research Training Network and Summer School (EAT) offer opportunities for discussions in the interdisciplinary research areas of education sciences, information technology and digital culture to young PhD candidates and PhD students, thereby furthering their postdoctoral careers. Particular attention is paid to exploring the value of developing transferable digital and intercultural skills as well as the commitment to international mobility.
